Last week, FBI Director Kash Patel testified in front of the U.S. House about the Epstein files — and continued the **Trump administration's efforts to hide information on Epstein's crimes.** 

Patel claimed that judges are blocking the release of some key documents. But the judges disagree, and are calling out the White House's "hurried efforts" to "confuse the public." One U.S. District Court judge said the Trump administration's move to limit the release of certain grand jury material is a "diversion from the breadth and scope of the Epstein files in the government's possession."

Rep. Thomas Massie, one of the lawmakers leading the discharge petition to force a vote in Congress on releasing the files, said, "I believe that Trump is trying to protect rich and powerful people who are his friends, and that is why this material is not getting released." Trump is also trying to protect himself. Our lawmakers must end this cover-up immediately.
